Brainerd Kennel Club Course Descriptions

Puppy Class:

BKC recently changed our curriculum to the new AKC S.T.A.R. Puppysm program. The AKC S.T.A.R. Puppysm is an exciting new program designed to get dog owners and their puppies off to a good start. The AKC S.T.A.R. Puppysm Program is an incentive program for loving dog owners who have taken the time to take their puppies through a basic training class. You'll attend a 6 week puppy/basic training class taught by an AKC Approved CGC Evaluator. Your instructor will administer the AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy test at the end of the course. Upon passing the test, you'll get an application to send to AKC® for enrollment in the AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy Program. All dogs are welcome to participate in the AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy Program including purebreds and mixed breeds.

The puppy class is for puppies 12 weeks and older and has had at least their second distemper/parvo combo vaccine. As the puppies get old enough, they are expected to continue to update their vaccinations, and bring proof to class. This is a six week course. Please **do not** bring your dog to the first class. **OFFERING AKC MICROCHIPPING FOR \$25.00 INCLUDES REGISTRATION.** Class sizes: minimum 3, maximum 10.

Advanced Puppy: Advanced Puppy class will keep your puppy active in continued training which is important for a well behaved member of the family and prepare your puppy for the Beginner class. For puppies under 1 year of age. Class sizes: minimum 3, maximum 10.

Beginner Obedience:

In the Beginner's Class, your dog will learn to: sit and stay on command, heel at your side when walking on leash, lay down on command, come when called on leash. The class will also help you prepare for the Canine Good Citizens test which is offered to you at no additional cost on the last night of class.

AKC's Canine Good Citizen (CGC) program is a certification designed to reward dogs who have good manners at home and in the community. The CGC test stresses responsible pet ownership for owners and basic good manners for dogs. All dogs who pass the 10-step CGC test may receive a certificate from the American Kennel Club.

Dogs must be 6 months of age; exceptions may be made for larger breed dogs that are 5 months old. Dogs must have current vaccinations for distemper/parvo combination and rabies, plus we highly recommend the bordetella vaccination. Please **do not** bring your dog to the first class. Beginners' Class includes the CGC test night the last week. Class sizes: minimum 3, maximum 15.

Companion Dog / Novice Obedience Class:

In this Class, your dog will learn to: polish the skills learned in beginner's class, stand for examination, heel at your side with attention on and off leash, come when you call off leash, complete the figure 8 exercise and master the left and right finishes. We will also work on life skills & good pet behavior. This is a pre-requisite course for the therapy dog class.

Dogs must have been through at least one BKC Beginner's Class to enroll in this class. If there is a question as to whether or not a student from the Beginner's Class should move on to the Novice Class, the decision is left to the recommendations of the Beginner's Class instructor. A dog may enter the Novice Class if the Novice instructor agrees, such as a person/dog that has taken classes elsewhere, or has been trained at home. Usually the first night the instructor will evaluate the skill level. Dogs must have current vaccinations for distemper/parvo combination and rabies, plus we highly recommend the bordetella vaccination. Class sizes: minimum 3, maximum 10.

Conformation Class: Tips and suggestions for competing in Breed Shows. No Registration, fees to be paid per session.

Therapy Dog Class: A therapy dog team is a partnership between a dog and handler who volunteer at hospitals, nursing homes, schools or any other institution that wishes to have a therapy dog visit. Therapy dogs must have a good temperament and be particularly sensitive and attentive to people. We will cover the different aspects of visiting facilities and individuals in their homes, etiquette for visiting and what is required of you as a therapy team. We will train and work on the 14 portions of the TDI test. We will also answer questions and concerns about volunteering and visiting, while also giving some guidelines and recommendations to begin volunteering. Provided we have enough students wanting to test, we will try to bring up a TDI (Therapy Dog International) evaluator to test at the end of the 9 weeks class. Your dog must be at least 1 year of age to take the therapy test. If you chose to take the TDI test, there will be a \$10 fee for testing. Dogs must have prior obedience training, Beginners and Novice classes. Dogs must have current vaccinations for distemper, parvo, rabies and (Bordetella recommended). Class size: minimum 2, maximum 10.

Nosework: Nosework is a popular new sport that mimics the work of detection dogs. In this class, dogs will be taught to search for the odor of essential oils. This is an ideal indoor activity to help keep dogs busy over the long winter! Dogs of all ages and training levels are welcome, there are no prerequisites! The only requirement is that your dog be able to relax in the presence of other dogs. The only equipment needed is a buckle collar, a leash, and a baggie full of kibble-sized, chewy treats. Note: If you are concerned about dog aggression issues towards humans or other dogs, please inform your instructor. If the dog aggression issues are extreme your instructor has the liberty to excuse you and your dog from the class in order to ensure the safety of others in the class.

Note: BKC requires that you **do not** attend class if you have a bitch in a heat cycle.
